

COOKIE POLICY

Effective as of July 1, 2025

1. General Provisions

1.1. The adoption of this Cookie Policy (hereinafter, the “Policy”) is one of the mandatory measures implemented by Belatravel LLC to ensure the protection of personal data, as provided for under Article 17 of the Law of the Republic of Belarus dated May 7, 2021, No. 99-3 “On the Protection of Personal Data” (hereinafter, the “Law”).

This Policy informs users of the information resource (insert name of information resource) (hereinafter, the “Website”), owned and operated by Belatravel LLC, about how, for what purposes, and on what legal basis their personal data may be collected, used, or otherwise processed through the use of cookies.

1.2. For the purposes of this Policy, cookies are defined as text files stored in the web browser of the user’s device (e.g., computer, mobile phone, etc.) when visiting websites, which are used to record and/or remember the user’s actions.

Other terms used in this Policy shall be interpreted in accordance with the definitions provided in the Law.

2. Categories of Cookies Processed

2.1. The Website processes the following categories of cookies:

Strictly Necessary (Technical) Cookies – These are essential for the proper functioning of the website’s software. They cannot be disabled and are not shared with third parties. These cookies are required to ensure the website operates correctly and to allow users to make full use of the services and features offered.

Functional Cookies – These cookies store information about user preferences, such as language settings or selected region. They are used to customize the website according to those preferences during subsequent visits and to enable useful features that enhance user interaction. This type of cookie is not shared with third parties.

Targeting (Analytical, Statistical) Cookies – These cookies are generated by web analytics services such as Google Analytics and Yandex.Metrica. They are used to assess the performance, popularity, and traffic of the website. These cookies collect aggregated, anonymized statistical data about user behavior on the website without identifying individual users.

Targeting (Advertising) Cookies – These cookies are used for marketing purposes and to improve the quality and relevance of advertising content. They help deliver more personalized advertisements and content based on the user's interests.

2.2. The Website processes cookies with the following storage durations:

Session cookies (strictly necessary) – These exist only for the duration of a user's visit and are deleted once the browser is closed.

Functional cookies – Stored for no more than one year.

Statistical cookies – Some are retained only during the session, while others are stored for no more than one year.

Advertising cookies – Stored for no more than one year.

2.3. The processing of targeting cookies is based on the user's consent to the processing of personal data. Upon their first visit to the Website, users are presented with a pop-up window offering them the option to accept or decline the use of cookies.

3. Cross-Border Transfer of Cookies

3.1. When using third-party targeting services to process cookies, Belatravel LLC may carry out the cross-border transfer of cookies to third parties listed in the Annex to this Policy.

3.2. The cross-border transfer of personal data contained in cookies may occur both to countries that provide an adequate level of protection for the rights of personal data subjects and to countries that do not ensure such a level of protection.

4. Rights of Personal Data Subjects and Mechanism for Exercising Them

5. Disabling Cookies in Browser Settings

5.1. Most browsers are initially set to accept cookies by default. Users can delete previously stored cookies by selecting the appropriate option in their browser's history. Additionally, some browsers allow users to browse in "incognito" or private mode, which limits the amount of data stored on the device and automatically deletes certain types of cookies after the session ends.

5.2. Users may also disable the use of cookies entirely by changing their browser settings. More detailed information on how to manage cookie preferences can be found on the official websites of respective browsers.
